

DO'S

1. Pay respect and earn respect: Bhutanese are proud about their country/society/life etc. Always speak politely and gently to the guide, driver, hotel staff, people you meet along. Bhutanese are very down to earth and simple people to go along with. But at any cost, disrespect will not be tolerated. They will immediately walk off their duties.
2. Bhutanese are very possessive about their Kingdom, the King (His Highness), the Queen (Her Highness) & the Royal Family. Please show respect to them.
3. While visiting the temples or any religious place, dress modestly and respectfully. The dress should cover shoulders and knees.
4. Silence should be maintained at the prayer halls.
5. Always walk clockwise while circling a stupa.
5. While at public restaurants, shouting/loud singing/loud laughing should be avoided. The same is not appreciated and at some places, not tolerated.
6. Carry your own medicines.
7. Buying and selling of any 'Antique' (without bill/ certificates) is legally prohibited.

DON'TS

1. Do not disrespect anyone.
2. Smoking in public areas is strictly prohibited and a punishable offence.
3. Do not touch any murals, religious paintings and anything in a temple without permission.
4. Drones (flying and carrying) are legally prohibited.
5. Do not feed the animals on highways and other places.
6. Do not spit here and there.
7. Do not take photographs without seeking advice from Guide. At some places, photography is strictly prohibited.
8. Do not shout or laugh loudly in any public place.
9. Do not pluck leaves/plants/flowers/fruits without permission
